# Mobile-8 Announces Merger Process

**JAKARTA, June 11, 2007** – During the recent Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (AGMS) and Extraordinary General Meeting of Shareholders (EGMS) held early May 2007, PT Mobile-8 Telecom Tbk (Mobile-8) was granted approval from its shareholders regarding the company's merger process with its subsidiary companies namely PT Komunikasi Selular Indonesia (Komselindo), PT Metro Selular Nusantara (Metrostel), and PT Telekomindo Selular Raya (Telesera) into Mobile-8, including approval on the Company's Merger Plan and the changes of the company's Articles of Association. Prior organizing the AGMS and EGMS, the company had also received an effective statement from the Indonesian Capital Market Body-Financial Institution through letter number S-2065/BL/2007 dated May 2<sup>nd</sup> on the company's merger plan and on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2007, the merger plan has now become effective.

As a result of this merger process, the legal entity of each of Komselindo, Metrostel dan Telesera were dismissed by law, as they are all now merged effectively into Mobile-8 without any liquidation process. Meanwhile, Mobile-8 as the surviving company will remain under the name of PT Mobile-8 Telecom Tbk.

Mobile-8 Corporate Secretary Fransisca said, "We are pleased with this merger process, as it will now further increase the company's efficiency with regards to our operational activities and operational costs. This merger process also clearly reflects our commitment to continuously improve the quality of our services towards our customers."



Mobile-8 that started its commercial service in December 2003, owes its origin to the acquisition of three licensed mobile cellular operators in Indonesia which are Metrosel, Komselindo, and Telesera. Prior to being acquired by Mobile-8, these operators provided mobile cellular services on the analog AMPS cellular networks in various areas such as Nanggroe Aceh Darussalam, Java, Bali, Sumatera, Sulawesi, Kalimantan and eastern part of Indonesia. Following the acquisition, Mobile-8 began progressively phase out the AMPS system to replace it with the current digital CDMA system and is able to provide nationwide services.

On national scale, Mobile-8 which has now recorded a total of 2.020.000 subscribers during the first quarter of 2007 is currently expanding its national services to various areas outside Java such as Sumatera, Kalimantan, Sulawesi, and Lombok commencing the second semester of 2007.
