Mobile-8 Support School Facility in Bantul, Yogyakarta

A continuous community program for Yogyakarta's earthquake victims

Jakarta, 21 December 2006 – PT Mobile-8 Telecom Tbk. (Mobile-8) reconfirmed its commitment to consistently support infrastructure recovery efforts following the recent earthquake disaster in Yogyakarta last May 2006 by providing one personal computer unit as part of the school's facility at Karang Gayam kindergarten and elementary school in Piyungan district, Bantul, Yogyakarta province.

Firman Alamsyah, Vice President Regional for Yogyakarta and Central Java areas, expressed Mobile-8's commitment during a handover ceremony attended by Minister of Communication and Information Sofyan A. Djalil who had symbolically presented such assistance to Bantul Regency Administration on Wednesday, 20 December 2006. Also presented during the ceremony were Vice Governor of Yogyakarta province, Directorate General of Post and Telecommunication Basuki Yusuf Iskandar, senior officials from post and telecommunication providers, telecommunication equipment vendors, and officers at both Yogyakarta province and Bantul regency administration.

Karang Gayam kindergarten and elementary school had been completely rebuilt, after nearly destroyed following the earthquake that rocked Yogyakarta province and some part of Central Java last May. "We realize that there are lots of losses due to the earthquake. Therefore, we fully support the Government recommendation to continuously participate in this program so that the learning process could resume as optimum as it should be," Firman elaborated.
